All prospective applicants must bring their Social Security card and a Texas driver's license, identification card or other form of government issued picture identification. **Applicants must also provide documentation from FEMA verifying that the applicant has been living in temporary FEMA trailers or Katrina cottages or has been displaced by either hurricanes Katrina and Rita. Please make child care arrangements.** Applicants on GHA public housing waiting list may apply for THU to HCV waiting list without losing their place on the Public Housing waiting list.

Elderly and disabled clients ONLY who are unable to apply in person may call (512) 869-6918, beginning February 8, 2010 between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm to apply by phone. All phone applicants will be required to leave their name, mailing address and phone number on the waiting list voice mail system. Applications for all phone applicants must be received by Friday, May 7, 2010, by 5:00 pm with a copy of the applicant's Social Security card, picture identification verification of disability in the form of (Social Security Award letter or Physician or Psychologist verifications dated within 60-days of application) and documentation from FEMA. **The THU to HCV waiting list will not accept any applications in person or phone requests after 4:00 pm Friday, May 7, 2010.** Any applicants who request a phone application and are not elderly or disabled, do not return the application on time or do not provide the required documentation will not be placed on the waiting list and will be deemed ineligible.

GHA does not discriminate based on race, color, religion, sex, disability, familial status, or national origin and is committed to compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
